

Struggling in school or on the job?

Help may be closer
than you think!



- Are you enrolled in a Tarrant County High School Equivalency (HSE) or Pre-HSE program?
- Do you have a history of learning disabilities or ADHD? Do learning disabilities or ADHD remain a barrier to your learning?
- Did you receive Special Ed services in school?
- Have you repeatedly fallen "just short" of passing a High School Equivalency test or the practice tests, especially in one area?
- Have you been enrolled in a program for a reasonable time without making progress?

Testing for formal accommodations on High School Equivalency tests is available for adults with evidence of learning disabilities and related challenges.

- **What are these accommodations?** Students who qualify MAY be awarded extra time for testing, a private room, or other accommodations according to need.
- **How do I qualify?** Students who meet the criteria for testing (such as that listed above) should ask for this help. With sufficient evidence of need, testing for learning disabilities can be provided at no cost through June 2017.
- **Where do I start?** Ask your teacher or Teacher Facilitator to call The Learning Center of North Texas (817-336-0808) and ask for Sylvia Nichols, who will contact you to begin the approval process.
- **How long does this process take?** The process may take up to six weeks; therefore, students should apply as soon as possible to take advantage of testing included in our local adult education grant.
